### Adopting a Greyhound

TAGS anticipates spending an average of \$500 on each Greyhound while it is in its care, in preparation for adoption to a forever home.

TAGS' non-refundable adoption donation is \$325 for all Greyhounds 8 years old and under and \$250 for seniors, age 9 and over.

#### The adoption donation includes:

- Neuter/spay
- All vaccinations (DHLPP, Bordetella, Lepto & Rabies)
- A CBC (complete blood count with serum chemistry panel)
- A tick-borne disease panel (performed by ProtaTek Lab\*)
- Heartworm test
- · Necessary dental cleaning
- A Martingale collar and a leash
- Basket muzzle

A \$75 deposit is required with submission of the application (\$50 of which is refundable and \$25 of which is non-refundable). The remaining \$250 or \$175 (senior) adoption donation is due when the Greyhound is delivered to the adopter's home.

An adoption application can be filled out on the TAGS website, downloaded from the website, picked up from one of our Meet and Greet events, or by phone request.

\*This test detects diseases prevalent in Texas transmitted from a tick bite. Proper treatment will eliminate these diseases.
